further violated the citizen's rights by adoption of a penal predetermined tiered water billing system.

Know the City of Antioch and all Council members are in violation of affirmed case law "Capistrano". The City of Antioch developed a predetermined tiered water rate system that is punitive and in violation of Proposition 13 and 218. See attached case G048969: Capistrano Taxpayers Association, Inc. v. City of San Juan Capistrano. See attached City of Antioch Notice of Public Hearing for development of punitive action and City wording. (page 2).

I claim that the illegal transfers from the Antioch Water and Sewer Funds are a taking from the public without basis in law, legal nexus or legal justification and that this taking of public funds is public malfeasance and grand theft pursuant to Penal Code 487, a felony. See attached copy of: Penal Code 487.

I provide a certified signed copy of the transfers from the Antioch Finance Director along with an email stating the transfers are based on a percentage of the Police Budget. A legal nexus is required by law and none exists. A percentage meets no legal requirement of the State Constitution. See Propositions 13, 26 and 218.

Also; that this transfer is a creation of windfall for the General Fund and is nothing short of a specific tax without voter approval as required by the State Constitution. See attached case C071906: Citizens for Fair Reu Rates et al v. City of Redding et al. See also Propositions 13, 26 and 218.

I also attach my letter to the City of Antioch, dated July 15, 2015 with exhibits and a response from the interim City Attorney, Derek P. Cole dated July 23, 2015.

Find also an opinion statement from retired City of Antioch attorney, William R. Galstan dated February 4, 2015 supporting the requirement of a legal nexus.

Know also that on or about July 23, 2015 the California Supreme Court upheld by publication the Appellate Court decision in Capistrano Taxpayers Association, Inc. v. City of San Juan Capistrano. That the Court; refused to "depublish" the opinion when pressured by the Governor and State Attorney General.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 3060 requirement is requested of the District Attorney to deliver to the Grand Jury this petition complaint.

I claim my right of "due process" under the fourteenth amendment of the United States Constitution. I also claim my first amendment right under the United States Constitution "to petition the Government for a redress of grievances" and the California Constitution, Declaration of Rights, Article1, Section 3.a. See attached copy of: Government Code 3060.

I claim, but do not limit, that my California State Constitutional right to vote on any tax has been violated by the City of Antioch and the individuals herein named. See Propositions 13, 26 and 218.

I do attest that constructive and legal notice was given to the individuals noted in this complaint and the City of Antioch on June 23, 2015 at the council meeting. See video at the City of Antioch web site. I do attest that constructive and legal notice was given to the individuals noted in this complaint and the City of Antioch in a letter dated July 15, 2015. See attached letter. I do attest that constructive and legal notice was given to the individuals noted in this complaint and the City of Antioch on July 28, 2015 at the council meeting. See video at the City of Antioch web site. I do attest that the aforementioned crimes do continue without correction by the City of Antioch.

I do claim that the individuals noted in this complaint have no rights of "Qualified Immunity" under 42 U.S.C. Section 198 as they have and had been one and all placed on constructive and legal notice of the violations prior to confirmation of the crimes by Council Vote on and including but not limited to June 23, 2015. See: Harlow v. Fitzgerald, 457 U.S. 800 (1982).
