<u>City of Antioch – Mobile/Mental Health Crisis</u> <u>Response Program Design Activities</u>

- **Project Goal = Pilot program development by 10/31/21**
 - Community outreach & engagement
 - Identification of performance measures (Data analysis, logic model development)
 - Model development (mobile, scalable, accessible)
 - Budget development
 - Partnership/asset mapping
 - Resource development/sustainability planning
 - RFP/RFQ development/Implementation timetable



Stage 1 - Program Design Community Outreach & Engagement

- Community advisory table convening/facilitation (2-3 meetings)
- Community resident survey (focusing on mostimpacted residents – African-American, Asian-Pacific Islander, Latinx)
- Key stakeholder interviews (public sector, re-entry, immigrant, disabled, service providers, etc.)



Stage 2 - Program Design Data Collection & Analysis

- Primary Data (Quantitative) APD from FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting, CCFD data
- Secondary Data (Qualitative) Key stakeholder interviews, community resident surveys
- Community (secondary) data Community advisory table, focus groups, resident interviews
