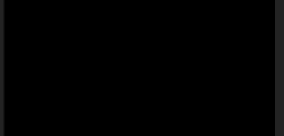

Dear Committee and Mr. Thorpe:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ The Enforcement Division received an anonymous complaint alleging that you may have violated the Act’s campaign disclosure provisions. The complainant alleges:

Campaign Statements Not Filed

No form 460 filed for contributions and he has claimed to have received \$80k

At this time, we have not made any determination about the allegations made in the complaint. We are requesting information, including documentation, about the allegations described above. **Please submit your response in writing within 14 days** from the date of this letter to Amber Rodriguez at arodriguez@fppc.ca.gov, or the address provided above.
