# **City of Antioch – Mobile/Mental Health Crisis Response Program Design Activities**

- **Project Goal = Pilot program development by 10/31/21**
  - **Community outreach & engagement**
  - **Identification of performance measures (Data analysis, logic model development)**
  - **Model development (mobile, scalable, accessible)**
  - **Budget development**
  - **Partnership/asset mapping**
  - **Resource development/sustainability planning**
  - **RFP/RFQ development/Implementation timetable**

# Stage 1 - Program Design

## Community Outreach & Engagement

- **Community advisory table convening/facilitation (2-3 meetings)**
- **Community resident survey (focusing on most-impacted residents – African-American, Asian-Pacific Islander, Latinx)**
- **Key stakeholder interviews (public sector, re-entry, immigrant, disabled, service providers, etc.)**

# **Stage 2 - Program Design**

## **Data Collection & Analysis**

- **Primary Data (Quantitative) - APD from FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting, CCFD data**
- **Secondary Data (Qualitative) – Key stakeholder interviews, community resident surveys**
- **Community (secondary) data – Community advisory table, focus groups, resident interviews**
