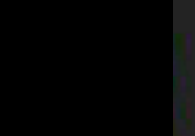

Dear Mr. Thorpe and Ms. Robinson:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ The Enforcement Division received an anonymous complaint alleging that you may have violated the Act's campaign finance and disclosure provisions. The complainant alleges:

Campaign Statements Not Filed; Not Filed Online (84605)

Lamar Thorpe claimed to have received \$80,000 in contributions to fight a recall

At this time, we have not made any determination about the allegations made in the complaint. We are requesting information, including documentation, about the allegations described above. **Please submit your response in writing within 14 days** from the date of this letter to Laura Mandler at lmandler@fppc.ca.gov, or the address provided above. Upon receipt of your response, we will review the information to determine whether or not to investigate the allegations.
